Thanks for reaching out about Constellations. Demand for this programming has far surpassed our capacity. In the meantime, here are some answers to frequently asked questions.

What is your approach?

At Constellations, we offer a natural environment full of creativity and love, where children engage in a wide range of activities to support their growth and development. Our program is predominantly outdoors and centers child-led play within a predictable rhythm that includes circle time, meal times, story, song and rest. Our days include opportunities to collaborate and work independently, to participate in a structured activity and engage in free play, to take healthy risks, to teach others, and to integrate through the senses. We embrace organic learning opportunities as they arise. The majority of our day is spent outdoors with nature being our greatest teacher.

Where are you located?

We are a separate entity from Reunity Resources, but located on the same property with predominantly outdoor classroom spaces year round. Indoor classrooms are available for napping, inclement weather and occasional use.

May I schedule a visit?

To preserve the rhythm and focus of our program, we offer open houses for interested families periodically rather than visits during the school day. Stay tuned for upcoming open house options.

What ages do you serve?

We are currently enrolling children ages 2-4. We are a small program growing gradually and organically, but do intend to grow with families into age 5/kindergarten in the coming year.

What schedules do you offer, and what are the costs?

We currently offer 2 and 4 day schedules, with a half and whole day option. Monday-Tuesday or Wednesday-Thursday are the 2-day schedule options to create continuity for the children's rhythm. Half days are 8:45-12:30 and whole days are 8:45-3:15 with a nap or rest time after lunch.

Tuition is standardized each month, not prorated per the number of days each month. Recurring payments are set up through Quickbooks upon enrollment.

2 Half Days is \$476+grt monthly

2 Full Days is \$692+grt monthly

4 Half Days is \$931+grt monthly

4 Full Days is \$1310+grt monthly

What is your calendar?

Our 12 month contract begins early August (aligned generally with Santa Fe Public Schools), and continues through the end of the following July. Scheduled days/weeks off for the year are posted at the beginning of the contract for everyone's planning purposes. A minimum of 30 days paid notice is required when children will be leaving the program during this time to ensure the spot can be filled. As a small program with low student-teacher ratios, this continuity is crucial.

Do you accept ECECD vouchers and will the NM free childcare program apply?

We are working on this, but not yet.
